

1094-B and 1095-B Forms and Filing

All employer groups under the Chamber Health Benefits Plan are required to file Tax Form 1094-B (employer) and provide employees with the individual return Tax Form 1095-B. For the 2023 tax year, SummaCare will prepare the necessary forms for all covered groups and make them available via SummaCare's employer portal, Plan Central. SummaCare uses data provided by employer groups, brokers and employees to populate these tax forms. The completed forms and information contained within them are ultimately the responsibility of the plan sponsor (employer group). Each plan sponsor should confirm the accuracy of all information reported on any form. Employers must provide copies of the 1095-B to each covered employee via a printed copy or providing a notice on how to receive a copy electronically.

SummaCare will not file any form electronically for tax year 2023. Any form filings are the responsibility of the plan sponsor and/or employee.
