



Prescription Drug Data Collection Reporting (RxDC).

SummaCare must report the total premium contribution by the employees for the medical plan as required under Section 204 of Division BB, Title II (Section 204) of the Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2021 (CAA) known as the Prescription Drug Data Collection Reporting (RxDC).

Section 204 requires group health plans (plans) and health insurance issuers (issuers) offering group or individual health insurance coverage to submit information about prescription drugs and health care spending to the Department of Health and Human Services (HHS), the Department of Labor (DOL), and the Department of the Treasury (the Departments). The Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) is collecting Section 204 data submissions on behalf of the Departments and OPM.

SummaCare will need information annually from small, large and self-funded groups. The first reporting period for calendar year 2022 is due to SummaCare by **5/01/2023**. Please provide data for the full calendar year (January 2022 through December 2022).
