What is the overall deductible ? If you have other family members on the plan , each family member must meet their own individual deductible until the total amount of deductible expenses paid by all family members meets the overall family deductible .
Are there services covered before you meet your deductible ?	Yes. Preventive care, primary care visits, diabetic eye exams, pediatric vision exam and frames and generic drugs are covered before you meet your deductible .	This plan covers some items and services even if you haven't yet met the deductible amount. But a copayment or coinsurance may apply. For example, this plan covers certain preventive services without cost sharing and before you meet your deductible . What is the out-of-pocket limit for this plan ?	For network providers \$9,200 individual / \$18,400 family	The out-of-pocket limit is the most you could pay in a year for covered services.
