SummaCare members can select the best available hearing aids in the market starting with a \$395 copay per hearing aid for Level 1 devices and \$695 copay per hearing aid for Level 2 devices.

How Hearing Aids Help

Hearing aids are battery-powered, electronic devices small enough to wear in or behind your ear. While they don't restore normal hearing, hearing aids can help you hear better when it's quiet and even when it's noisy. Here's how they work:

- A microphone picks up sound around you
- A digital processor amplifies sounds that are important for communication and reduces disruptive sounds.
- A receiver sends these amplified sounds into your ear
