Additional Preventive Care and Screenings Covered by Your Plan for \$0:

- Annual Flu Shot
- Abdominal aortic aneurysm screening
- Alcohol misuse counseling
- Bone Density Testing for Osteoporosis (ages 65+ or if you are high risk)
- Breast Cancer Screening/Mammogram offers a \$10 incentive for completion
- Cardiovascular disease risk reduction and testing
- Cervical Cancer Screening: HPV Screening/Pap Smear (ages 30–64)
- Colorectal Cancer Screening (ages 45–75) offers a \$10 incentive for completion
- Depression Screening
- Diabetes Screening: A1C, retinal eye exam, nephropathy screening
- HIV screening
- Lipid Profile Screening (cholesterol) as needed
- Lung Cancer Screening
- Nutrition, Physical Activity and Urinary Incontinence Counseling as needed
- Obesity screening and counseling
- One-time Hepatitis C Screening (for adults aged 18–79)
- Pneumonia Vaccinations (ages 65+ or if you are high risk)
- Smoking Prevention/Cessation Counseling
- Sexually transmitted infections screening and counseling
